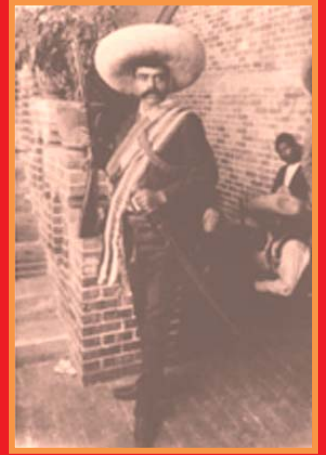


Emiliano Zapata (1879-1919) was a village leader, farmer and horseman who became an important leader in the Mexican Revolution (1910-1920). He organized and led peasants during the battles of the Mexican Revolution, joining forces with other revolutionary generals and was instrumental in bringing down the corrupt dictatorship of Porfirio Díaz in 1911 and subsequent government leaders. Zapata supported agrarian reform and land redistribution and his insistence on land reform became one of the pillars of the Revolution. He was ambushed by Mexican troops in 1919. Zapata remains a folk hero in Mexico.
